There were 30+ who regularly attended, with about half of those being from the communities surrounding Long Hill Chapel. Attendees got a 13 week course on wise money management and what the Bible says about money, and on average those attending, paid down over \$3000 worth of debt during the 98 days.

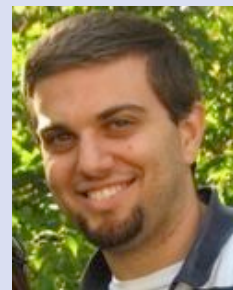

matter where you are in your journey, a small group is the right choice. Please be in prayer about how you can join a small group.

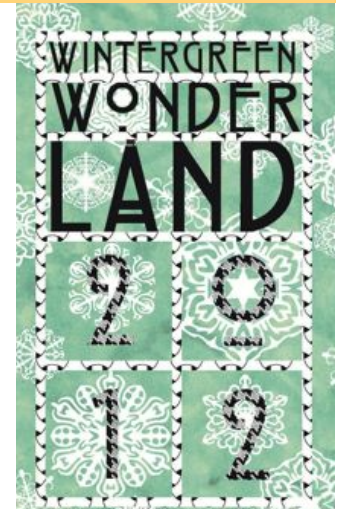

Online Giving

Long Hill Chapel is now able to accept online giving through ACH checking account transfers via our online church database, Church Community Builder (CCB). There is a link on our website for [CCB](#) and online giving under the "Connect" tab, as well as step by step instructions.

Once you've registered for a CCB username and password, you login there will be a tab labeled "Give." This will allow you to make a one time or set up recurring gifts through your checking account (weekly, monthly, etc). Online giving will only be available for ACH checking account transfers, not debit or credit cards.
